

MASTERS wants to promote apprenticeship in small and micro enterprises, developing and validating a set of practical and methodological tools to support the professional development of in company tutors operating in SMEs, VET trainers and job counsellors, so as to allow them to implement efficient and high quality apprenticeship programs.

MASTERS is a complex and ambitious project, with six concrete intellectual outputs generated by six partners from four countries. We have scheduled the project for 24 months implementation.

CURRICULUM PROGRAMME FOR IN-COMPANY TUTORS (IO2)

MASTERS consortium has finalized the curriculum programme for incompany tutors working in SMEs and involved in apprenticeships programs. The curriculum programme aims to provide the incompany tutors with the right skills/competences for managing and delivering successful training to trainees at the workplace. The curriculum is delivered in the form of a MOOC, including a Resource Pack/Tool Kit for offline training. It is structured into 3 modules:

- 1. Current EU WBL context
- 2. Working effectively with learners
- 3. Working with training/sending institutions

MASTERS consortium has also finalised the Curriculum programme for job counsellors to provide them with the right skills/competences for managing and delivering high-quality apprenticeships. The curriculum programme consists of 4 modules and focuses on strengthening career counsellors' knowledge on apprenticeship schemes across Europe and competences to work more effectively with learners and employers. - develop a toolkit for the recognition of informal and non-formal learning acquired through WBL







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
